- Minutes from meeting 8<sup>th</sup> March 2016: Action Points arising from this meeting:  
A new set of keys for the football Clubs joint Notice Board was to be obtained by the Parish Clerk for the football Clubs. **action Clerk**  
Last year's senior Club accounts to be sent by Clerk to P Rackliffe as they had had trouble with their book keeping and couldn't locate these. **Action Clerk**  
Junior Football Club still short of space for juniors. PR suggested Cranleigh Show Ground and to pass a contact for this area onto BW. **Action PR**  
All old metal work had now been cleared from the recreation ground.
- Pitch Maintenance: A schedule for remedial and ongoing works had been sorted out in addition it was felt that worm casting was needed and funding for this possibly obtained from the Football Foundation Emergency Fund. The Senior Club pointed out that they do most of their white line marking and therefore part of the £2000 allocated towards line marking may become available for worm casting. PR to record the line marking done by Senior Club members. Junior Club felt they would not need any coloured marking white may also save costs and they were to speak to the contractor. **Action BW**
- Contracts for next season: The contracts were signed by the Clubs and the Clerk.
- Any other matters arising: It had been established that the team playing on a Sunday was the U17s which had now disbanded. RW was to look into the possibility of raising funds for new goal posts. **Action RW**
- The Senior Club asked if the recreation ground railings could be used to hand sponsor banners during matches and it was thought so long as they did not obstruct then this was agreed.
